4 THIS MATTER came before the Court on Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment. The
5 Court considered Plaintiff's Motion, the Supplemental Declaration of Lord Nigel Featherston,
6 and the records and files herein. The Court previously found defendants Linda J. Lightfoot and
7 Charles F. Childs in default by Order dated November 8, 2002 (based on the pleadings and
8 declarations then submitted). The Court has also found, based on the Supplemental Declaration
9 of Lord Nigel Featherston filed in support of plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment, that there
10 is sufficient evidence to support Plaintiff's claim that he received approximately 58,000 Illegal
11 E-mails due to the Defendants' actions. The Court has also found that, pursuant to
12 RCW 19.190.040, Plaintiff is entitled to a judgment in the amount of \$500 per wrongful e-mail
13 received due to the defendants' actions. And the Court has taken judicial notice that Plaintiff is
14 seeking a Default Judgment in the principal amount of only \$250,000, which is far less than the
15 \$29,000,000 judgment that would be allowed by RCW 19.190.040;

16 Now, therefore, it is hereby:

17 ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment
18 is GRANTED in the principal amount of \$250,000.00, and it is further

19 ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that joint and several Judgment is hereby
20 entered in favor of Plaintiff Lord Nigel Featherston against Defendants Linda J. Lightfoot (aka
21 Linda J. Beasley) and Charles F. Childs in the principal amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand
22 Dollars (\$250,000.00), and it is further

23 ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff is hereby awarded judgment for
24 its expenses and attorneys' fees and costs incurred herein in the amount of \$2,500.00, and it is

1 ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all amounts awarded herein shall accrue
2 interest at the statutory rate of 12% per annum.
